



#### **4) Oregon Trail Interpretive Kiosks**

Von Domitz reported the Travel Information Council approved a \$30,000 budget to get the Oregon Trail Interpretive Kiosk renovation project started. The original structures are in mostly good condition and the current plan is to keep them, but replace the interpretive panels inside the structures. Some initial conversations have been started to gauge interest with potential partners.

Keeler reminded the committee members about the Regional Commemorative historical markers that were created to celebrate Oregon's sesquicentennial in 2009. The committee managed to get three markers installed in two regions, but has not pursued any new ones in the other five regions. Keeler requested the topic for the next meeting agenda.
